Main features of the procedure: The National Library (NB) is moving collections, materials and equipment between the locations in Oslo and Mo i Rana, or to and from external institutions at home and abroad. There can be a need for services connected to transport, as well as packing, loading, unloading and any temporary storage. Collection transport can include collections up to several hundred years old and of great historical value. The collections can consist of books, manuscripts, maps, periodicals, various film and audio formats, photographic materials, broadcasting materials, hard drives, and other materials owned by the National Library of Norway or its owning external collaborating partners. Transport of assemblies requires high security from dispatch to reception. When transporting to and from abroad, the transporter must ensure customs processing in accordance with the current rules for cultural objects. Relevant shipping methods can be packages/boxes, plastic boxes, whole and half pallets, or entire semi-trailers on 33 whole pallets. The tender also includes sending lending and/or materials such as pallet goods to and from libraries, Cinematek and other domestic institutions, as well as addressees abroad. In some cases NB shall also cover return costs - this will be agreed in each case. The tender also includes dispatches of equipment.
