Reducing this gap is important for achieving success with the project. Stimulab shall be the start and set the direction for the multi-year alteration work Health and Welfare - headed for 2040. The objective of the procurement Through this procurement, we would like to get the correct competence in order to carry out a good Stimulab project. All Stimulab projects shall follow the triple diamond and the tenderer must offer competence in the execution of all the diamonds, even if we do not know what the delivery is at the start of the project. The diagnosis phase will reveal what the delivery will be and how far the implementation will take. Since the project is a part of Stimulab, it shall have an open and experimental approach and it has therefore not been given in advance what the concrete delivery in each project will be.
