(Referred to from IV.1.11) — The services in scope of this procurement process are healthcare services which fall under 'social and other specific services' in Section 7 of the Public Contracts Regulations 2015 ('PCR'). In accordance with Regulation 76 PCR, the process is to

set up a framework agreement and will follow a procedure similar to the open procedure. However, NHS England and the contracting authorities using the framework are only bound by the parts of the PCR that specifically apply to social and other specific services. For the avoidance of doubt, the rules that apply to the open procedure under Regulation 27 and framework agreements under Regulation 33 do not apply to this procurement. All providers that meet the minimum requirements set out under the procurement process will be appointed to the framework agreement. There will be no maximum number of providers appointed. Providers must be able to ensure their ability to begin service provision from the 20 November 2020, if required by any contracting authority. NHS England reserves the right to conduct any number of framework refreshes throughout the term of the framework agreement. A refresh will allow verification of existing providers' continuing ability to meet requirements and will also allow new entrants to be appointed to the framework agreement.
