It is also envisaged that stand alone precinct improvements works will be carried out to a number of flat complexes, and for adaptive re-use of existing buildings to provide quality homes. Standalone enabling and building investigation works maybe also required to be carried out on projects. Projects will be tendered and Contractor will be appointed as per CWMF guidelines.
