The Competition Policy School shall offer workshops and lectures on competition law and policy (procedures, restrictive agreements, abuse of dominance, merger control State aid control, information on enforcement in the digital sector, including Digital Markets Act).

Next to general principles of competition law and policy, a special emphasis shall be placed on sharing practical expertise and case studies highlighting investigative techniques, agency building and the benefits of convergence between competition laws (including procedures) and how to facilitate cooperation amongst competition authorities. The Competition Policy School shall take place in person for a full week, i.e., 5 working days for the Competition Policy School plus any necessary travel time, either in the third or fourth quarter of 2026 or, if not possible, in the first quarter of 2027. One out of the five course days shall be organised on the premises of the Contracting Authority (DG COMP, Madou square, 1210 Sint-Joost ten Node, Brussels).
