CA20 is fabricated in >80 sub-modules before shipment to the identified site. CA20 has associated misc. equipment such as steel grating including their clips; ladders including their fasteners; temporary conduit and piping supports including U-bolts, nuts, and fasteners; hoist rings and inserts, spray nozzle box assembly and hardware. 1.
