By setting requirements for the equipment's lifetime, warranty time, as well as access to spare parts, we ensure a long lifetime of the equipment. These requirements will extend the lifetime of the equipment and the following reduce the need for new equipment and the accompanying extraction and extraction of raw materials for production and production.
