However, the number of lots for which a single bidder can receive an award is limited to one lot. If a bidder submits the most economically advantageous offer according to the awarding criteria in more than one lot, the bidder will receive the award in the lot where he has achieved the highest score (Example: Lot 1: 90 points; Lot 2: 100 points; the award goes to Lot 2). In the case of a tie in the scores of the same bidder's bids in multiple lots, the award will be given to the first lot.
