The facility must meet the requirements in the grant letter from Enova. This includes i.a. the requirements in NEK IEC PAS 80005-3. The procurement is for the procurement of land power installations. In addition the procurement includes the following options: 1. Cost reduction - Land supply system for CCS ships only. 2. Cable tower to CCS 3. Convert 4. Advanced cable management system, quay front 5. Back-up cables 6. Extended service contract The contractual terms for the delivery shall be in accordance with the standard contract terms for Oslo municipality's procurement of goods. The land power plant shall supply the ship at Kneppeskjær quay on Sjursøya. Kneppeskjær quay is divided in the east and west. The contracting authority would like the onshore power plant to be completed simultaneously with the completion of the quay at Kneppeskjær pier, 15 June 2027. The contract has an estimated extent of between NOK 15 million and NOK 20 million.

Options:

Description of the options: Tenderers shall price the cost reduction if the land power plant is scaled down to only deliver to land power to CCS ships. Tenderers shall give a price for a fixed cable tower on the quay with 3 350 A plugs. The crane shall be in accordance with NEK IEC PAS 80005-3 and it shall be a minimum of 10 metres long from the barrier call-offs. The cables shall be independent of each other and have automatic compensation for tides. The arm shall be able to be rotated at least from 0 to 60 degrees on each side. The cable tower shall be able to be connected without a normal outlet cabinet. When this option is signed, the call-off cabinet (UT-1) will be withdrawn and the cables from the land power plant shall be terminated in an interface cabinet on the cable tower at work height/ground level. The interface cabinet shall contain HMI as described in 4.10. Tenderers shall give a price for a converter with a transformer (DYN) with zero point, so that the ships can also be supplied with a TN network. The converter shall be supplied with a 350 A plug IT network in accordance with NEK IEC PAS 80005-3 and be able to supply with 2 125 A plug TN networks in accordance with NEK 400 and NEK IEC 60309. Tenderers shall give an option price for a portable cable dispenser/cable management unit that can be used for the power socket cupboards at the quay. It shall be possible to use 1 or 2 plugs without pulling out more cables than necessary. The installation shall have a sufficient number of cables with a length of 50 metres and plugs and it shall fulfil the requirements in NEK IEC PAS 80005-3 and NEK IEC/IEEE 80005-2. The delivery shall be a closed system to prevent snow and ice on the cable drums. The tenderer shall give a price for two 25 metre back-up cables. An option shall be offered on a Service Agreement. A fixed price shall be given per annum for three years after the original service contract has expired.
